The Arch Research and Education Foundation will award 4 grants per year with the maximum amount awarded of \$2500.00 Please follow the following submitting guidelines:

- We will consider applications for 1 year grants only
- We do not fund salaries
- We do not buy equipment, we will fund supply purchases
- We do not cover overhead costs such as light, rent, etc.

The grant application must be completed in full in order to be considered for this grant.

Grants will be awarded four times yearly, award dates are as follows:

January 1	application due on/before October 1
April 1	application due on/before January 1
July 1	application due on/before April 1
October 1	application due on/before July 1
